CME in your Workflow

We created PATHFINDER because we know that radiologists learn best from their own work.

Each case holds a lesson: a miss reveals blind spots, a hit builds confidence. PATHFINDER makes sure you see them all.

PATHFINDER users have always enjoyed the intrinsic rewards of self-directed lifelong learning. Now, they can also earn tangible rewards – CME credits.

PATHFINDER makes hindsight insight

We developed a novel CME activity called Case-Based Reflective Learning, accredited by the UC San Diego School of Medicine, to encourage and recognize radiologists who take a moment to review pathology outcomes.

The CME activity runs from August 1, 2025 – July 31, 2026, in four three-month sessions.

PATHFINDER users earn 1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit[™] for every 40 rad-path matches reviewed, up to 10 credits per session, 40 credits per year.

How to Participate

All PATHFINDER users are automatically enrolled in the CME activities – no additional cost or sign-up required.

Users receive in-app notifications when a CME session is about to start or end, and when the credit claim period nears expiration. A red dot on the notification icon indicates that unread messages are available:



How to Earn Credits

Simply login and use PATHFINDER. Upon login you are directed to the Matches page, which lists all the rad-path matches available for review. Every case reviewed during a CME session contributes to credit accrual:




Visit the CME tab anytime to see details on upcoming, current, and completed CME sessions. The CME tab also displays a link to the course syllabus, the number of credits earned, and instructions for claiming credits.

How to Claim Credits

Credits must be claimed within 14 days after the end of a session. The credit claim process is administered through the CloudCME® platform.

Click the **Claim Credits** button on the **CME** page to show instructions.



Briefly, you'll visit the CloudCME site, enter the PATHFINDER activity code, complete a brief post-activity questionnaire, and enter the number of credits you've earned. CloudCME will then generate your CME certificate.
